

2 Year Bible Reading Plan

1) Read **two chapters** a day and you will get through the whole Bible in two years.

2) Take **Sundays off** from reading as a day to reflect on what you have read or a day to get caught up.

3) Take the **first week of July** and the **last week of December** off from reading to reflect on what you have read or a day to get caught up.

4) **Pray** every day before you read. You can pray something like this: *“Incline my heart to your testimonies. Open my eyes to behold wonderful things out of your law. Teach me your way, O Lord, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name. Satisfy me in the morning with your steadfast love. Show me in all the Scriptures the things concerning your Son”* (Psalm 119:36; 119:18; 86:11; 90:14; Luke 24:17).
