How to Use this Resource

This devotional is designed to help you get the most benefit from the Sunday sermon and can be used as individuals, couples, or a family. If young children are involved, parents may have to re-word things to their level. It would be easy to go these questions with benefit in as little as 15 minutes or as long as 30. You can also use this as a guide to help you re-teach this passage to someone else in a disciple-making context. Use it any way that helps build God's kingdom, and may you be blessed in doing so.

Sunday

- Read Luke 19:1-10. Reflect back on the morning sermon.
- What verse(s) had the most impact on you?
- Find someone to share that with tonight during your community group or during the week.
- Pray about these things.

Monday

- Read Luke 19:1-4,7. Who was Zacchaeus? What did he do and what was he known as?
- Read Ephesians 2:1-3. How is sin a problem in all people?
- Why do people have a hard time accepting themselves as sinful?
- Have you accepted this about yourself?
- Pray about these things.

Tuesday

- Read Luke 19:5. How was Jesus seeking Zacchaeus?
- Given who Zacchaeus was, why is it significant that Jesus was seeking him?

- Read John 6:44. What does Jesus say about those who come to him for saving faith?
- How should this encourage us and give us assurance?
- Pray about these things.

Wednesday

- Read Luke 19:9-10. What came to Zacchaeus' house?
- Read Luke 19:6-8. What was the evidence of this salvation?
- Does your own life reflect this same kind of response to God's saving grace?
- Pray about these things.

Thursday

- Read Psalm 51. How would you describe the tone of the prayer?
- How does David describe himself?
- How does he describe his sin?
- Do you repent like this?
- Pray about these things.

Friday

- Read 1 Peter 2:9-12. How are God's people described?
- What are God's people to proclaim?
- How are their lives meant to endorse their message?
- As a Christians, are you intentional in pursuing this kind of lifestyle?
- Pray about these things.

Saturday

- Read Luke 19:11-27. Summarize the passage in one sentence.
- Ask God to prepare your heart to hear his Word.
- Ask God to help you understand what is said and be receptive to change.
- Ask God to be with the pastor as he preaches and the people as they listen.
- What kind of response should we have to conviction of sin?
- Pray about these things.
